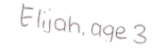

For more details, Dionne, our Centre Manager, will be happy to assist you.

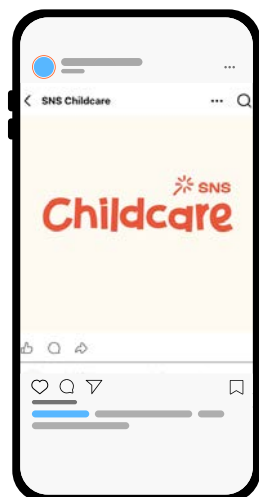
