GADGETS AND GIZMOS

Tombot puppies are a robotic emotional support animal that have been designed for individuals facing health adversities such as Alzheimers. The dog, named "Jennie", is battery operated and reacts to touch. It can wag it's tail and bark on command. Studies show the behavioural and psychological symptoms of Alzheimers can be reduced by having an emotional attachment. Jennie acts as that emotional attachment without the need for care.





UNDERSTANDING COMPLEX CARE AND THE ROLE OF REGISTERED NURSES

Complex care refers to supports for those who live with multiple, interrelated health conditions or high-intensity needs. These needs may include but not limited to;

- Catheter or Bowel Care
- Ventilation care
- PEG feeding
- Neurological care
- Wound care

This type of care is tailored to each individual to help them remain safe, comfortable and independent in their home.

Our registered nurses play an important role in delivering complex care services. They are highly trained professionals who can assess health needs, develop care plans, manage wounds and administer medications. Additionally, they can provide education to both participants and families.

We understand that navigating complex health needs can feel overwhelming. Our goal is to provide care that not only supports clinical needs but promotes independence, dignity, comfort and overall wellbeing. Our team works closely with participants and their support network to ensure the needs and goals are being met.

SNS PARTNERS WITH CHORUS

SNS is pleased to announce our newest partnership with Chorus! We will be working alongside Chorus by assisting them with resourcing both aged care and NDIS shifts.

Chorus is a for-purpose organisation that work alongside people to support them live a life they choose, focusing on those who live with a disability, mental illness or senior.

Chorus operate in a network of twenty local, small and self-sufficient teams. They operate from Joondalup to Albany.
